Description: A description of the database is posted at www.JamesMCalm.com along with the User's Manual. The manual describes the database features and contents in detail and presents illustrations of its use.

Refrigerant Database Update Subscriptions are no longer available. The prices shown for database licenses include only the 2001.07.31 release.

Computerized Version: This version contains 643 data summaries on refrigerants, compatibility, and toxicity. It provides more than 7,400 citations. Retrieval software is included, subject to an accompanying license agreement; prices for users outside the United States include a \$30.00 software license fee. System requirements for the database and software are included in the description and in the User's Manual, both posted at www.JamesMCalm.com. Distribution will be via the Internet as e-mail attachments of file downloads except that diskettes may be used for the initial release.

Report Version: Subscriptions for the printed version have been discontinued; reports may be ordered as database documents.

Database Documents: The database identify sources for documents cited in the database. Approximately a third are distributed through the database and may be ordered at the rates shown.

Service Charges: COD service is available for domestic shipments by express delivery; the added cost is \$20.00. Additional charges (minimum of \$25.00) will apply for special documentation or invoicing as well as confirmations to subscription agencies.
